Once the children are back and settled after a short playtime, we will open the doors for the Records of Achievement session. We anticipate this being at approximately 10.15am.

During the session those parents who have more than one child in year groups 1-4 will be able to work with both/all children in one classroom.

Children will be encouraged to bring in certificates, photos, souvenirs and anything else that they are particularly proud of, to place in the Record of Achievement. Each classroom will also have some activities that the children

can complete independently, or with their grown up, and which can also be placed in their Record of Achievement.

We understand that some may not want some original certificates to be kept in Records of Achievement files in school, particularly as this is a new initiative. If this is the case please feel free to send those certificates in earlier in the week and we will photocopy them and return the original. Obviously, we will not be able to do this on the Friday morning because of the numbers involved. The records of achievement session is open to all parents of children in years 1 to 4. The session will conclude at 11.30am. Parents /carers are welcome to join and leave at any time up to that point and stay for as much or as little time as you wish.
