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### Family worship

There will be no family worship this week (11th January).

From week beginning 15th January. Early years will be going into Family worship again.

For parents/ carers who are new to Early Years, this takes place every week, parents, carers and family members are invited to attend, during these time children share their home achievements, 'let your light shine' certificates are given out, as chosen by the class teacher, and birthdays for the week are celebrated. Parents are asked to arrive at main reception for 2:45pm.

For children in nursery this worship often runs until 3:15-3:30, I am aware this conflicts with pick up time, you will not be charged for nursery on these occasions. Unless you are using wrap around care.

We politely ask that if you would like to collect your child before the worship has finished you do so at 2:45 to avoid your child having to leave in the middle of family worship.

## Early years performing arts club

We are excited to provide an extra-curricular performing arts club for our early years' children. This will be run by Michelle Moss School of Performing Arts and will be supported by myself and Miss Hulme.
